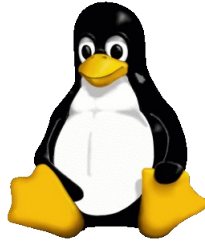


List of Linux Commands



The following is a short list of commands to work on the Linux terminal (command-line interface)

<code>ctrl-alt-t</code>	# open terminal/shell
<code>pwd</code>	# print working directory
<code>ls</code>	# list display files and/or folders of the wd
<code>mkdir <i>name-of-folder</i></code>	# make a new directory/folder
<code>cd <i>name-of-folder</i></code>	# change to directory
<code>cd ..</code>	# change to the directory below
<code>cp <i>file-name path</i></code>	# copy file to another directory
<code>mv <i>file-name path</i></code>	# move file
<code>top</code> type "q" to quit from top	# display information about running processes
<code>cat <i>file-name</i></code>	# show file content
<code>head <i>file-name</i></code> <code>head -n <i>file-name</i></code>	# show first (default = 10) lines # show first n lines
<code>tail <i>file-name</i></code> <code>tail -n <i>file-name</i></code>	# show last (default = 10) lines # show last n lines
<code>chmod +x <i>file-name.sh</i></code>	# turn a bash (Bourne Again Shell) script executable
